

HELLENIC RARITIES COMMITTEE ANNUAL REPORT – 2006

The following evaluations concern reports sent to the Committee for 2006. Also included are previous years' records of birds (or groups of birds) not included in G.Handrinos & T.Akriotis "The Birds of Greece" (Helm, 1997) or in the HRC 2005 Annual Report.

The taxonomic order followed is compliant to the last revision of the Association of European Records and Rarities Committees (AERC-TAC, 2003b).

The details given for each record are analyzed with the following order:

- 1. Prefecture or island.
- 2. City, village or location.
- 3. Number, sex, age and subspecies (if identified).
- 4. Date/s of observation.
- 5. Bird's condition (dead, exhausted or wounded, ringed).
- 6. Additional information-facts (photographs, sample, acoustic or visual media, other).
- 7. Name/s of observers with the order given in the form.

I. Observations of rare species approved by the Committee

Where necessary, there is a small descriptive text. The chronological appearance of the species in Greece may change in the future if older observations arise and become accepted:

Tundra Swan Cygnus columbianus bewickii

Evros, Evros Delta, 1 adult male, 4/2/1997, ringed in the Netherlands, (HBRC). Evros, Evros Delta, 1 adult male, 6/12/1998, ringed in Russia, (HBRC). Xanthi, Porto Lagos, 15 adults, 8/1/2005, photo, (C.Vlachos, Z.Rizou). Evros, Evros Delta, 200 individuals, 2/2/2005, photo, (C.Vlachos, N.Petrou). Evros, Evros Delta, 350 individuals, 20/2/2005, (C.Vlachos, Z.Rizou). All the aforementioned birds belong to C. c. bewickii subspecies. The count of 473 birds in Evros is the highest for this species in Greece. The Committee is aware of many more observations, showing that the species has become relatively common mainly in the wetlands of Northern Greece (especially in heavy winters). However, there has been no publication or indexing of these records, as well as registration to the Committee. For the time being, the Committee acknowledges only the records listed in BoG and all the registration forms submitted and approved (a total of 16), and waits for the others to be submitted.

Snow Goose Anser caerulescens

Evros, Evros Delta, 1 adult white morph, 31/12/2002-31/1/2003, (E.Makrygianni, E.Kapoutsis, A.Athanasiadis, D.Vangeluwe).

This is the 1st record of `this species in Greece. There was suspicion that this may have been an escaped bird. After examining all the available facts, the Committee concluded that the possibility of an escaped bird were minimal and accepted the record.

Red-breasted Goose Branta ruficollis

Long-tailed Duck Clangula hyemalis

According to BoG, this is the 17th record of the species in Greece.

Smew Mergus albellus

White-headed Duck Oxyura leucocephala

The Committee is aware of, and awaits the submission of, several other observations.

Great Shearwater *Puffinus gravis*

Xanthi, sea area between Porto Lagos and Nestos Delta, 1 first year, 24/10/2006, photos, (A.Christidis).

This is the 1st record of this species in Greece. BoG details a rejected record from *Crete, in 1987. The species is a very rare visitor in the Mediterranean Sea. There are* only 3 observations from the Mediterranean coasts of Israel and 1 from Lebanon (Y. Perlman in litt.) (Birding World Magazine 19 (11): 481).

European Storm-Petrel *Hydrobates pelagicus*

The Committee is aware of many more observations in central and southern Aegean. However, there has been no publication or total indexing and submission to the Committee. Therefore, the Committee acknowledges only these particular records and waits for the other.

Cattle Egret Bubulcus ibis

The Committee is aware of many more observations, indicating that this species has become relatively common, and in the near future it will be excluded from the list of species that this Committee is interested. However, there is no publication or total indexing of these records. Therefore, the Committee accepts only the registered records, awaiting registration forms for all other sightings.

There are 23 previous records of the species in Greece.

Imperial Eagle Aquila heliaca

This bird had been ringed as a chick in Hungary on 21/6/2005, and was "fitted" with a satellite transmitter.

There are 23 previous records of the species in Greece. The Committee is aware of, and awaits the submission of, several other observations.

Eurasian Dotterel Charadrius morinellus

These 21 birds in Louros is the highest count for this species in Greece. The Committee is aware of, and awaits the submission of, several other observations.

Sociable Lapwing Vanellus gregarius

Great Snipe Gallinago media

Long-billed Dowitcher *Limnodromus scolopaceus*

Red Phalarope Phalaropus fulicarius

2 miles, 11 miles, 1 miles, 0 //0/2002, pileto, (2111 mileo, 112 million).

These are the 4^{th} and 5^{th} observations of this species in Greece. The last record was from Evros in 1980.

Pomarine Skua Stercorarius pomarinus

This is the 7^{th} observation of this species in Greece, 16 years after the last (sea area 10 km S of Nafplion, 1990).

Long-tailed Skua *Stercorarius longicaudus* Kerkyra, sea area between Kerkyra and Ereikousa, 1 juvenile, 18/8/2006, photos, (P.Latsoudis, F.Katsigiannis, K.Papaconstantinou, K.Papaconstantinou).

This is the 3^{*rd*} *observation of this species in Greece.*

Pallas's Gull Larus ichthyaetus

There is only 1 previous record of the species in Greece (Crete, 1996).

Black-legged Kittiwake Rissa tridactyla

This is the 8^{th} observation of this species in Greece, 7 years after the last (Crete, 1998).

Laughing Dove Streptopelia senegalensis

This is the 7^{th} observation of this species in Greece, 10 years after the last (Lesvos, 1994).

Great Spotted Cuckoo Clamator glandarius

Attiki, Sounio, 1 juvenile, 27/5/2006, photo, (E.Stavrakas, T.Gaitanakis, G.Beriatos, N.Tsiopelas, N.Probonas).

This observation, a newly fledged chick fed by Magpies (Pica pica), is the first proved nesting record of this species in Attiki.

Tengmalm's Owl Aegolius funereus

Little Swift Apus affinis

This is the 2^{nd} observation of this species in Greece, 17 years after the last (Kefallonia, 1998).

Blue-cheeked Bee-eater *Merops persicus* Lasithi, Kato Zakros, 2 adults, 13/5/1999, (G.Olioso). Lesvos, Petra, 1 adult, 3/5/2006, sketch, (S.Wytema).

There are 24 previous records of the species in Greece.

Richard's Pipit Anthus richardi

Naxos, Alyki, 1 adult, 5/10/1996, (N.Probonas, K.Vitzilaios, A.Rogers). Naxos, Kampos Agiassou, 1 adult, 10/9/2001, (N.Probonas).

The Committee is aware of, and awaits the submission of, several other observations.

Rock Pipit Anthus petrosus littoralis

Attiki, Shinias, 1 adult, 14/11/2004, photo, (C.Vlachos, Z.Rizou). Irakleio, Almyros, 4 adults, 27/3/2006, photo, (M.Dretakis).

The Shinias record is the 1^{st} of the species and the Irakleio record the 3^{rd} , as there is another observation (Crete, 2004) which is now listed as 2^{nd} (HRC, 2006).

Yellow Wagtail *Motacilla flava flavissima* Antikythira, Katsaneviana, 1 adult, 30/9/2006, photo, (A.Galanaki, T.Kominos).

According to BoG, this subspecies recorded in Antikythira is very rarely observed in Greece.

Citrine Wagtail Motacilla citreola

Evros, Evros Delta, 1 adult female, 17/4/2003, ringed, (HBRC). Evros, Evros Delta, 1 adult male, 21/4/2003, ringed, (HBRC). Ileia, Kotyhi, 1 adult male, 31/3+1/4/2006, photos, (F.Katsigiannis, H.Tselepis).

There are 19 previous records of the species in Greece. The Committee is aware of many other observations, especially in the eastern Aegean islands, indicating that this species has been observed quite frequently during the last years and may have its status in Greece changed. However, there is no publication or total indexing and submission of these records to the Committee. Therefore, the Committee is currently acknowledging only those observations listed in BoG and all the submitted and accepted records (a total of 22), and waits for the others to be submitted.

Bluethroat Luscinia svecica

Serres, Vrontous, 1 adult male, 27/5/2006, photo, (C.Vlachos).

White-throated Robin Irania gutturalis

Lesvos, Sigri, 1 adult male, 4/5/2006, photo, (E.Opperman, K.Mullarney).

This is the 6^{th} observation for the species in Greece. The Committee is aware of more observations in Lesvos which may together indicate that this species continues to occasionally breed on the island.

Desert Wheatear Oenanthe deserti

There are 10 previous records of the species in Greece. The record is the 1^{st} winter record of the species, for there is another observation (Crete, 1997) which is now listed as 2^{nd} (HRC, 2006).

Yellow-browed Warbler *Phylloscopus inornatus* Attiki, Shinias, 1 individual, 25/12/2006, ringed, photos, (HBRC).

This is the 4th *observation of this species in Greece, 14 years after the last (Paxoi, 1992).*

Red-breasted Flycatcher *Ficedula parva* Ioannina, Grammos, 1 adult male and 1 adult female, 2/8/1986, (A.Sakoulis).

Isabelline Shrike *Lanius isabellinus phoenicuroides* Antikythira, Batoudiana, 1 adult female, 15/5/2006, photos, (T.Kominos).

This is the 3^{rd} observation of the species in Greece, 6 years after the last (Crete, 2000).

Southern Grey Shrike *Lanius meridionalis aucheri/elegans* Messinia, Divari, 1 adult, 9/12/2006, photos, (A.Sakoulis).

This is the 1st observation of this species in Greece.

Rosy Starling Sturnus roseus

Kozani, Lygeri, 300 pairs, 14/6-26/7/2003, photos, (P.Dougalis, I.Dougalis, A.Vasilopoulos).

This is the 6^{th} confirmed nesting record of this species in Greece, 8 years after the last (Kilkis, 1995).

Common Rosefinch Carpodacus erythrinus

Attiki, Ymittos, 1 adult male, 8/4/2006, (K.Papaconstantinou, V.Chatzirvasanis, I.Rigas, N.Kardakari). Antikythira, Batoudiana, 1 first year, 2/10/2006, ringed, photo, (HBRC). Attiki, Lykavittos, 1 adult male, 4/10/2006, (E.Stavrakas).

There are 25 previous records of the species in Greece. The spring observation in Lykavittos is the first confirmed nesting record of this species in Greece.

Rustic Bunting *Emberiza rustica* Attiki, Shinias, 1 adult, 5/12/2005, photos, (C.Vlachos). *This is the* 4th *observation of this species in Greece, 6 years after the last (Zakynthos, 1999).*

Little Bunting Emberiza pusilla

Lesvos, Haramida, 1 first year, 17/10/1997, ringed, (HBRC).

This is the 2^{nd} observation of this species in Greece, 33 years after the last (Amvrakikos, 1964).

II. Acceptance of new species due to current taxonomic changes and splits

HRC, complying with the current list of the Association of European Records and Rarities Committees (AERC TAC 2003a, AERC TAC 2003b), classifies the following taxa as separate species:

Balearic Shearwater Puffinus mauretanicus

The Committee classifies the Balearic Shearwater as a monotypic species, separated from the Yelkouan Shearwater (Puffinus yelkouan). There are 2 records of Balearic Shearwater in Greece (sea area between Porto Lagos and Nestos Delta, 1976 and sea area 10 km NW of Patra, 1990).

Yellow-legged Gull Larus michahellis

The Committee classifies the Yellow-legged Gull as a separate polytypic species, fully separated from the Caspian Gull (Larus cachinnans). In Greece, Yellow-legged Gull is a common resident species nesting in coastal areas, islands and, locally, in wetlands inland. In some islands appears mainly as a summer visitor departing at fall, but generally in Greece it occurs as a winter visitor and as a passage migrant.

Caspian Gull Larus cachinnans

The Committee classifies the Caspian Gull as a monotypic species not including the Yellow-legged Gull (formerly L.c.michahellis) anymore. In Greece, it is a common winter visitor and passage migrant.

III. Rare species observations accepted by the Committee but included in Category C

According to the official checklist of the Association of European Records and Rarities Committees (AERC TAC 2003a, AERC TAC 2003b), the following species is included in the European Avifauna:

Ring-necked Parakeet Psittacula krameri

The Committee received positively Panagiotis Latsoudis' (contributor of HRC) report "Preliminary distribution study of the Ring-necked Parakeet (Psittacula krameri) in Greece" which supported this species being listed in Category C of the List of the Birds of Greece, due to the species' stable, and increasing, breeding population in Greece for many years.
